Baja California Sur recorded 378 thousands workers during 2016, mainly in commerce. In respect to the national level, the state represented 0.7% of the workers in the commerce services.



The Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of Baja California Sur exceeded 133 billion pesos in 2015, and contributed 0.8% to Mexico's national GDP.

Foreign Direct Investment

Baja California Sur received 433.4 million dollars in Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in 2016, which was 1.6% of FDI received in Mexico. Of all the FDI received by the state, most was toward the manufacturing industry.


