Employment

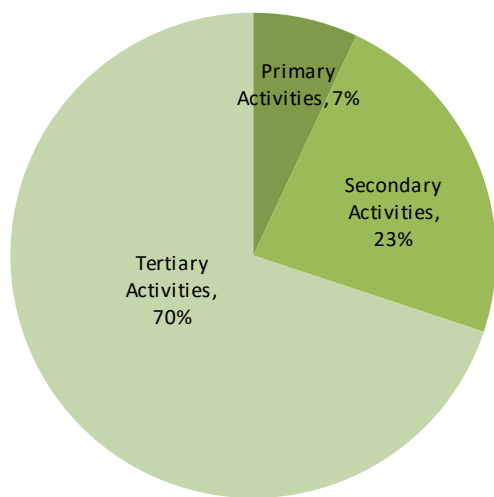
Chiapas recorded 1.9 million workers during 2016, mainly in the agricultural and in commerce activities. In respect to the national level, the state represented 10.8% of the workers in the agricultural sector and 2.9% in commerce.

Economy

The Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of Chiapas was almost 294 billion pesos in 2015, and contributed 1.7% of Mexico's national GDP.

Tertiary sector, which includes wholesale and retail trade and retail trade services, contributed with 70% of the state's GDP in 2015.

Foreign Direct Investment

- Chiapas received 107.7 million dollars in Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in 2016, which represented 0.4% of FDI received in Mexico. Of all the FDI received by the state, almost all was toward the mining industry.

Chiapas recorded an average salary for IMSS contribution of \$236.0 in 2015, which was below the country's average of \$294.0.

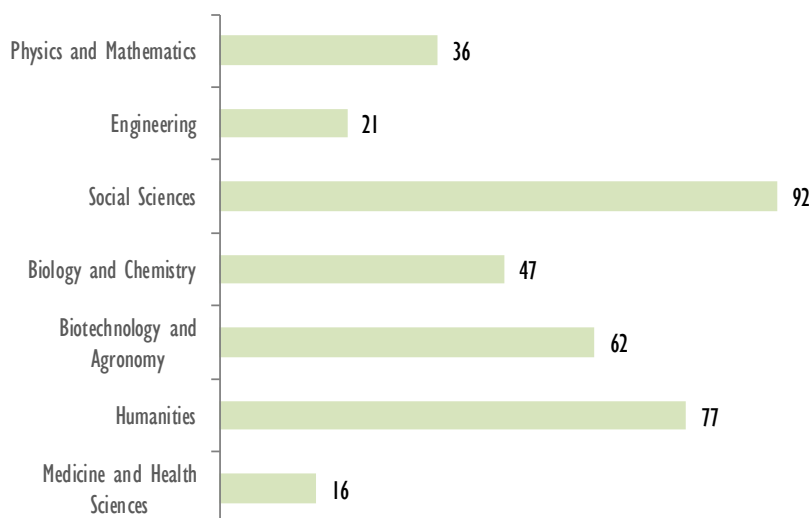
