Employment

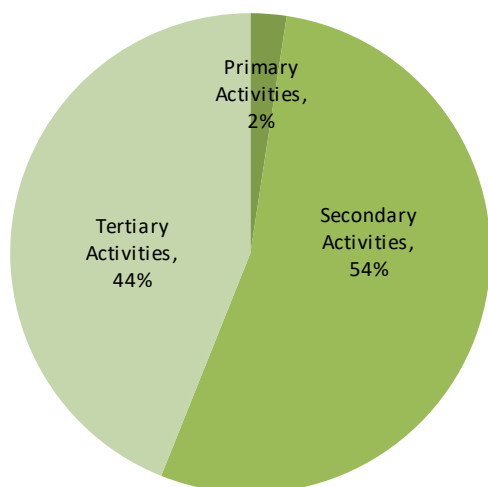
Coahuila recorded more than 1.3 million workers during 2016, mainly in manufacturing industry and commerce. In respect to the national level, the state represented 4.5% of the workers in the manufacturing industry and 2.2% in commerce.

Economy

The Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of Coahuila was almost 690 billion pesos in 2016, and contributed 3.7% of Mexico's national GDP.

Secondary sector, which includes manufacturing and construction, contributed 54% of the state's GDP in 2016.

- Coahuila received 1,187.8 million dollars in Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in 2016, which represented 4.4% of FDI received in Mexico. Of all the FDI received by the state, most was toward the manufacturing industry.

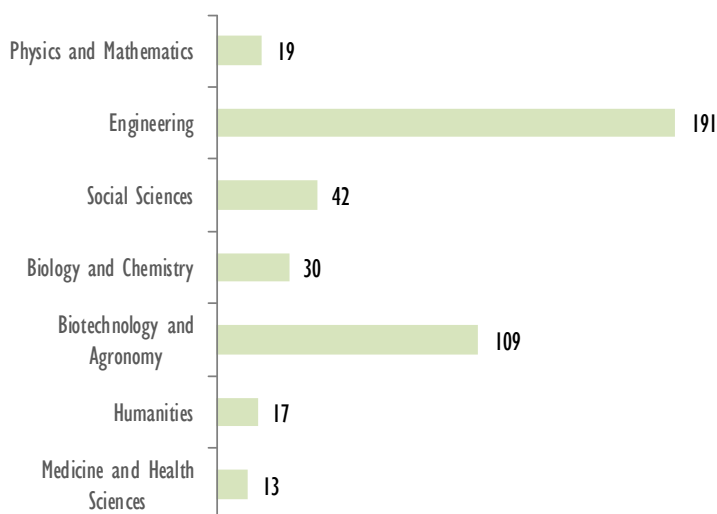
