Employment

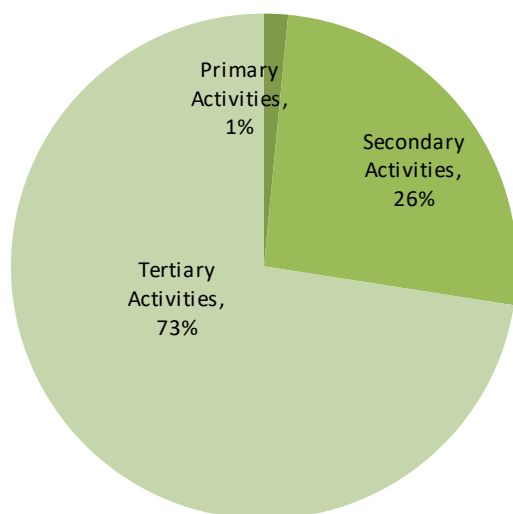
The State of Mexico recorded 7.1 million workers during 2016, mainly in the commerce services. In respect to the national level, the state represented 15.7% of the workers in the commerce sector.

Economy

The Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of the State of Mexico exceeded 1.6 trillion pesos in 2016, contributing with 8.9% of national GDP.

Tertiary sector, which includes trade and real estate services, contributed with 73% of the state's GDP in 2013.

Foreign Direct Investment

- The State of Mexico received 1,828.1 million dollars in Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in 2016, which represented 6.8% of FDI received in Mexico. Of all the FDI received by the state, almost all was toward manufacturing industry, followed by the construction industry.

Salaries

The State of Mexico recorded an average salary for IMSS contribution of \$310.2 in 2016, which was below the country's average of \$317.9.

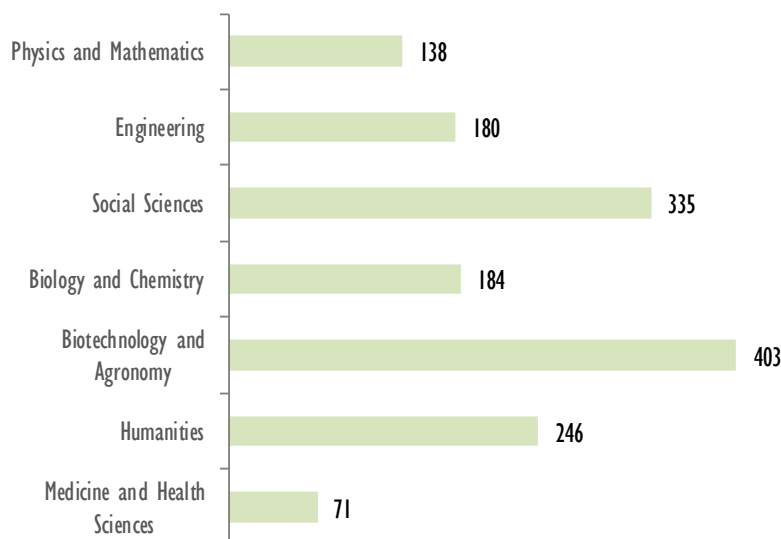
