Employment

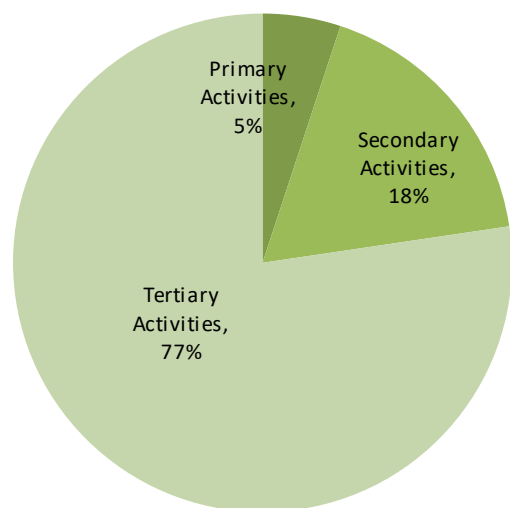
Guerrero recorded 1.4 million workers during 2016, mainly in the agricultural sector and in commerce. In respect to the national level, the state represented 6.9% of the workers in the agricultural sector and 2.2% in commerce.

Economy

The Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of Guerrero exceeded 249 billion pesos in 2015, and contributed 1.4% of Mexico's national GDP.

Tertiary sector, which includes trade and real estate services, contributed with 77% of the state's GDP in 2015.

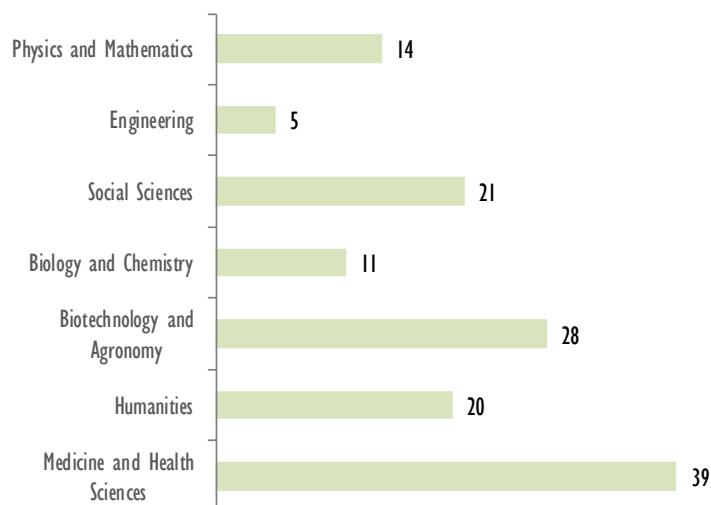
