Employment

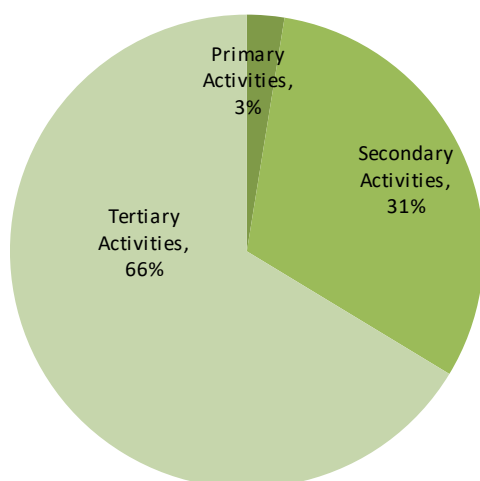
Morelos recorded 801 thousand workers during 2016, mainly in the commerce services. In respect to the national level, the state represented 1.7% of the workers in the commerce sector.

Economy

The Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of Morelos recorded 199 billion pesos in 2015, and contributed 1.1% to Mexico's national GDP.

Tertiary sector, which includes trade and real estate services, contributed 66% of the state's GDP in 2015.

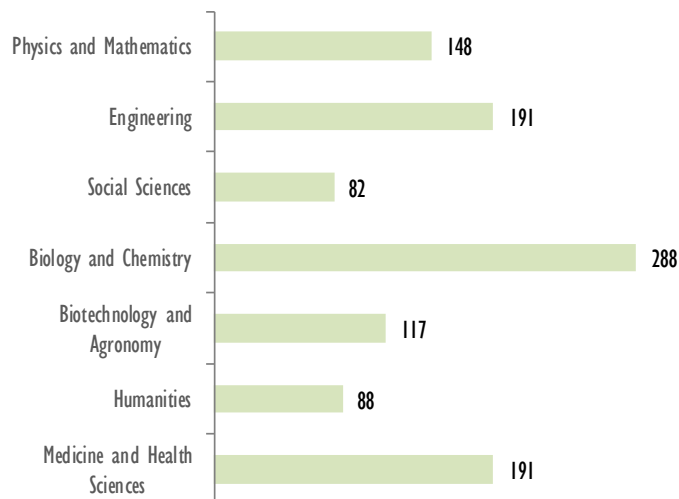
