Employment

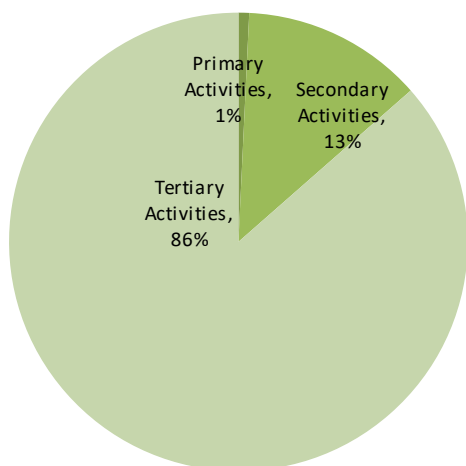
Quintana Roo recorded 776 thousand workers during 2016, mainly in accommodation and food services and commerce. In respect to the national level, the state represented 3.9% of the workers in accommodation and services and 1.3% in the commerce.

Economy

The Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of Quintana Roo reached almost 303 billion pesos in 2016, and contributed 1.6% to Mexico's national GDP.

Tertiary sector, which includes accommodation and food services, contributed 86% of the state's GDP in 2016.

Foreign Direct Investment

- Quintana Roo received 171.2 million dollars in Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in 2016, which was 0.6% of FDI received in Mexico. The most of all the FDI received by the state was toward the accommodation services and food and beverage preparation services.

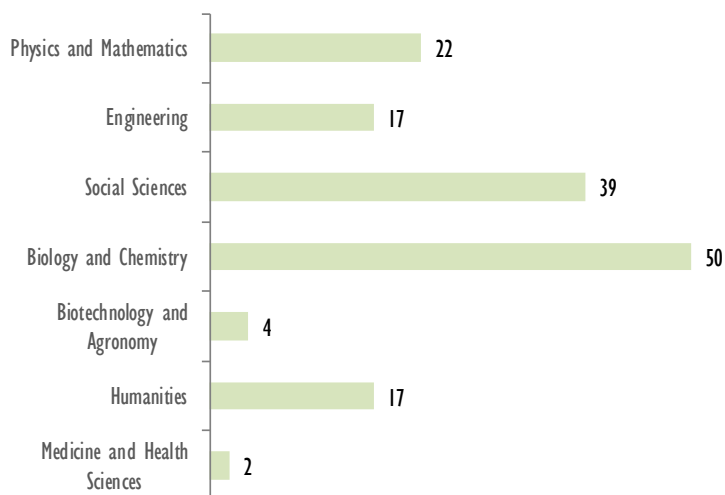
