Employment

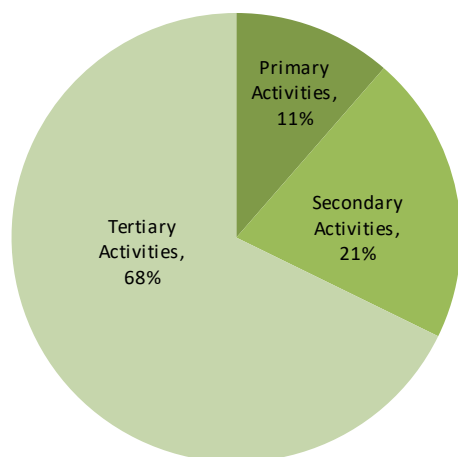
Sinaloa recorded 1.3 million workers during 2016, mainly in commerce and agriculture. In respect to the national level, the state represented 2.7% of the workers in commerce and 3.4% in agriculture.

Economy

The Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of Sinaloa exceeded 385 billion pesos in 2015, and contributed 2.2% to Mexico's national GDP.

Tertiary sector, which includes trade and real estate services, contributed 68% of the state's GDP in 2015.

Foreign Direct Investment

- Sinaloa received 330.9 million dollars in Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in 2016, which was 1.2% of the total FDI received in Mexico. Of all the FDI received by the state, almost was toward transportation, postal services and warehousing services.

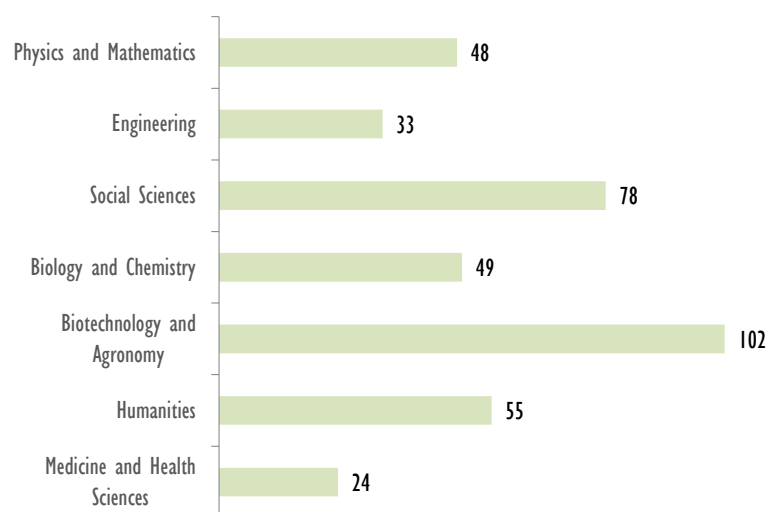
