## Employment

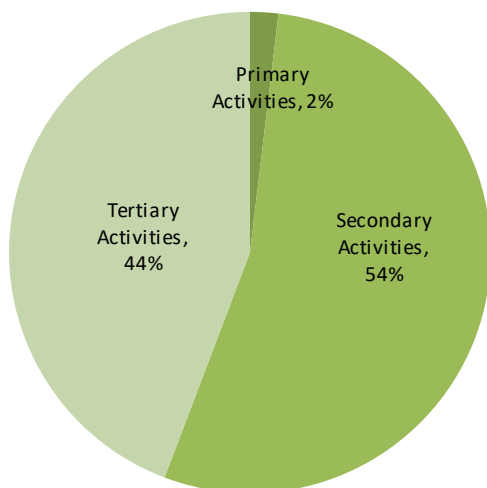
Tabasco recorded 949 thousand workers during 2016, mainly in commerce. In respect to the national level, the state represented 2.1% of the workers in commerce.

## Economy

The Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of Tabasco reached 398 billion pesos in 2015, and contributed 2.3% to Mexico's national GDP.

Secondary sector, which includes mining, contributed 44% of the state's GDP in 2015.

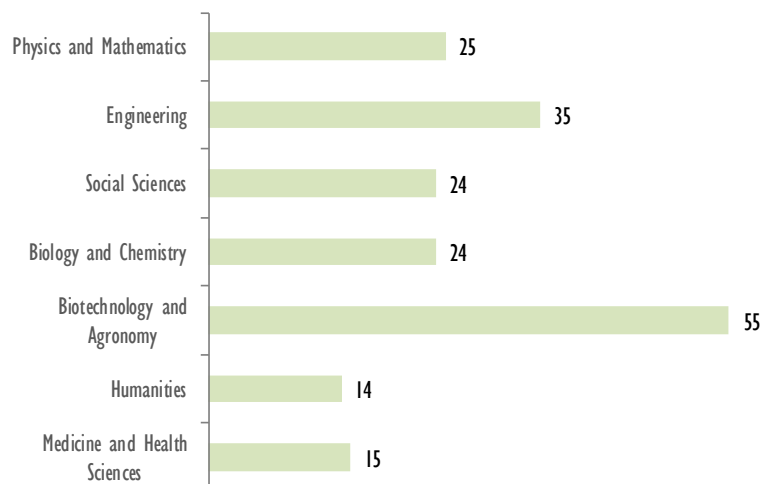
