The state of Tlaxcala has great infrastructure that provides access to the main access roads, such as the international airports of Mexico City and Puebla and the sea port of Veracruz, which is the most transited port in Mexico.

Employment

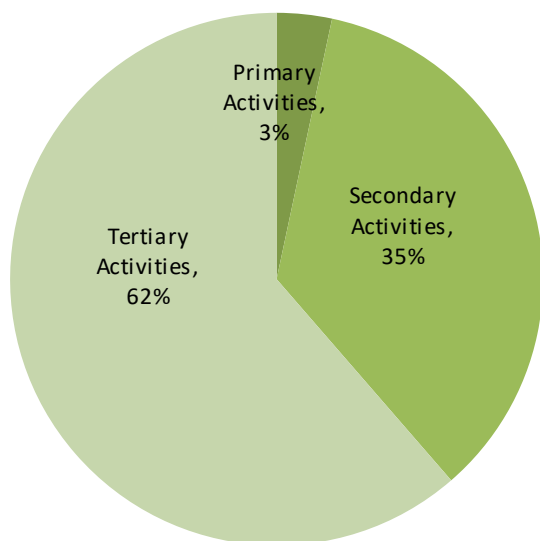
Tlaxcala recorded 560 thousand workers during 2016, mainly in the manufacturing industry. In respect to the national level, the state represented 1.7% of the workers in the manufacturing industry.

Economy

The Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of Tlaxcala exceeded 110 billion pesos in 2016, and contributed 0.6% to Mexico's national GDP.

Tertiary sector, which includes trade and real estate services, contributed 62% of the state's GDP in 2015.

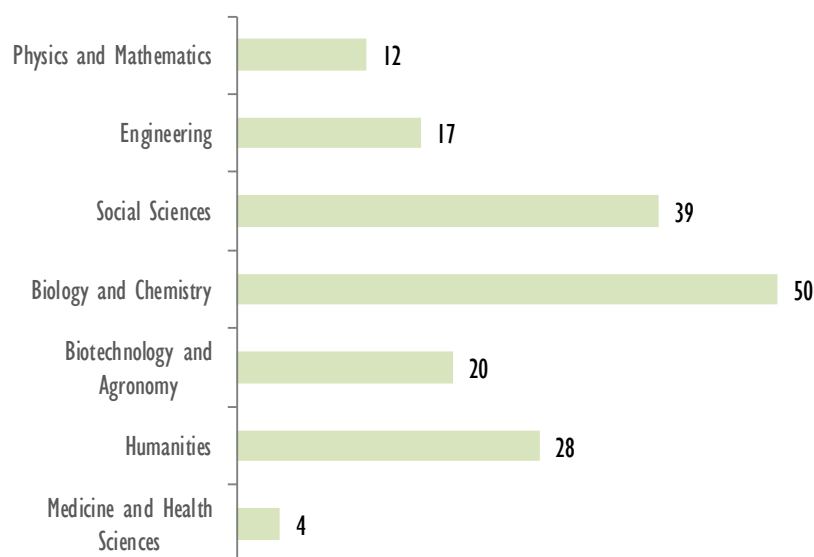
